

Auto Repair Reference Center (ARRC)

Are you in charge of locating repair information for automobiles of different makes and models? Take a look at Auto Repair Reference Center (ARRC) in the list of electronic resources available on the website of the [State Library of Pennsylvania](#). Commonwealth employees with a valid State Library borrower's card can access this information, and everyone else can view it at the State Library as well.

By choosing from the year, make and model of the vehicle, you can look at repair information or schematics of various systems such as brakes or exhaust. Some models, such as the VW Beetle, go back to 1954. Diagnostic and maintenance information are also available for many vehicles.

To get to the electronic resources from the main State Library web page follow these steps:

- On the top right-hand side click on "State Agencies" link
- Click on "State Library Services"
- Click on "Collection for State Agencies" on the right-hand middle side of the page
- Click on the third link for electronic resources
- This is a list of all the electronic resources that Commonwealth employees may access anywhere they can get to the Internet
- Under the heading "General Research" you will see the link for the ARRC
- On the left-hand side you will see a space to put in the number on the back of your library card and your last name.
- Put in the year, make and model of your vehicle and away you'll go!
