Notes:

1. Total 2016-2017 LSTA grant to the Office of Commonwealth Libraries: \$5,467,151
2. The LSTA grant is used to provide: 1) support for library services; and 2) administrative and operational support for libraries in Pennsylvania. More information about this support is listed below.
3. The total LSTA grant to the Office of Commonwealth Libraries does not include grants made by the Institute for Museum and Library Services (IMLS) directly to Pennsylvania libraries, educational organizations, and individuals (e.g. National Leadership Grants, Laura Bush 21st Century Librarian

Program, etc.) These grants vary significantly each year. In 2016-2017, IMLS grants to Pennsylvania organizations were \$ 1,196,191.

4. Support for Library Services:

The amounts listed for each county in the chart above have two components:

- a. Service Support Shared by All Pennsylvania Libraries: Examples include POWER Library Chat with a Librarian service; POWER Library authentication services; One Book, Every Young Child; Summer Learning Program; training for library staff, boards and friends; and scanning/preservation of rare and unique Pennsylvania library materials to make them available from POWER Library and the Digital Public Library of America. Shared program costs are proportionally allocated to each county by population.

- b. Service Support Provided to Specific Pennsylvania Libraries: Examples include: Spark! (Pennsylvania Integrated Library System) and direct library grants for programs or professional development. These costs were assigned to those participating libraries.

5. Administrative and Operational Support:

The amounts listed in the chart above do not include \$1.8 million in LSTA funds used by the Office Commonwealth Libraries to provide administrative and operational support to Pennsylvania's libraries. This includes staff to develop, coordinate, and evaluate programs; provide professional development, advisory and reporting services; and provide outreach and rare collection support for the State Library.
